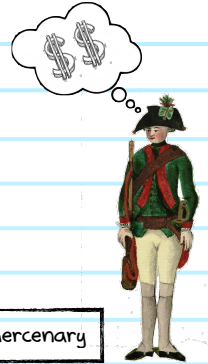


THE PATRIOTS SUFFER A STRING OF LOSSES

LOSING NEW YORK

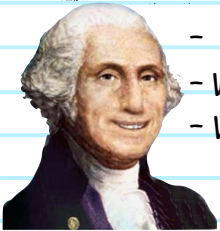


- British leave Boston - Strategy: Move attacks to middle states to isolate rebellion to Massachusetts
- British fight Hessians (German) **MERCENARIES**. What are mercenaries?

- What was the Significance? !!

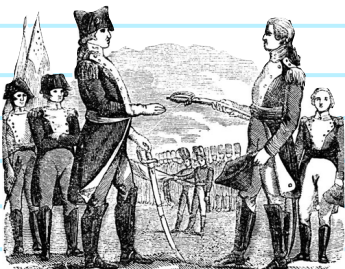
- In 1777, the Continental Congress fled Philadelphia. Why?

- Strategy: take the South and march northward to middle colonies



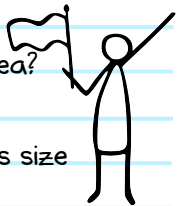
- Who was the British Commander who quickly captured GA and SC, then moved south to Yorktown?
