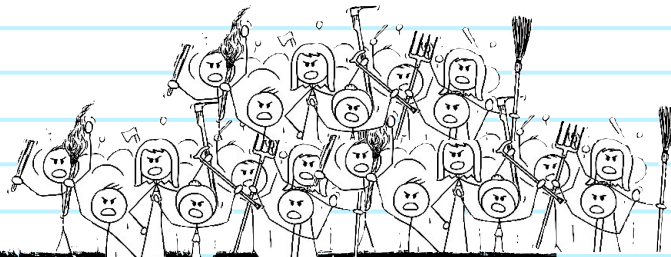
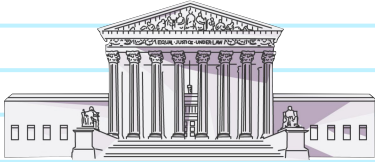
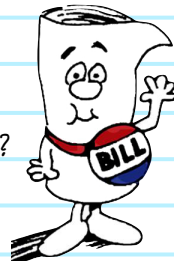
- War for Independence

- negotiated the peace treaty





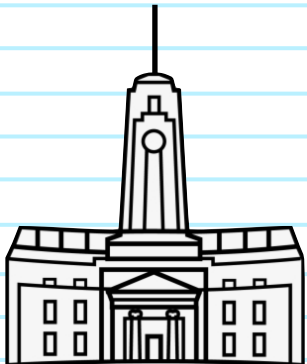
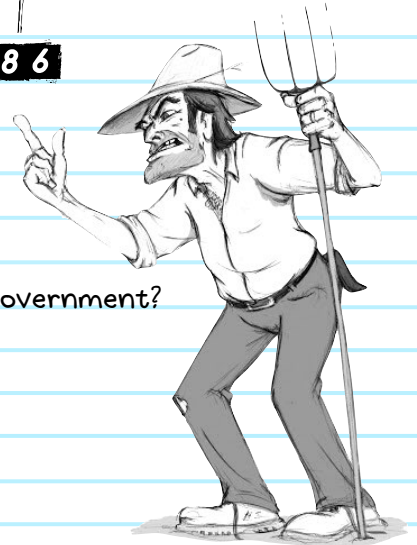
ARTICLES OF CONFEDERATION WEAKNESSES
