Pennant Research Activity



Teaching Guide

Notes

Each pennant has the name of a contemporary Indigenous leader in Canada, along with instructions directing students to research the individual and display key information on their pennant using a combination of images and writing. The only additional guideline I recommend you give students is that the pennant should be completely covered, with no 'white space'. You might choose to include additional instructions for your students depending on your needs. For example: direct students to include a certain word count or maximum percentage of space that can use images. Students should have no difficulty finding information about their Indigenous leader but if they do, advise them to include the keywords 'Canada', 'activism', or 'Indigenous' along with the individual's name for better search results.

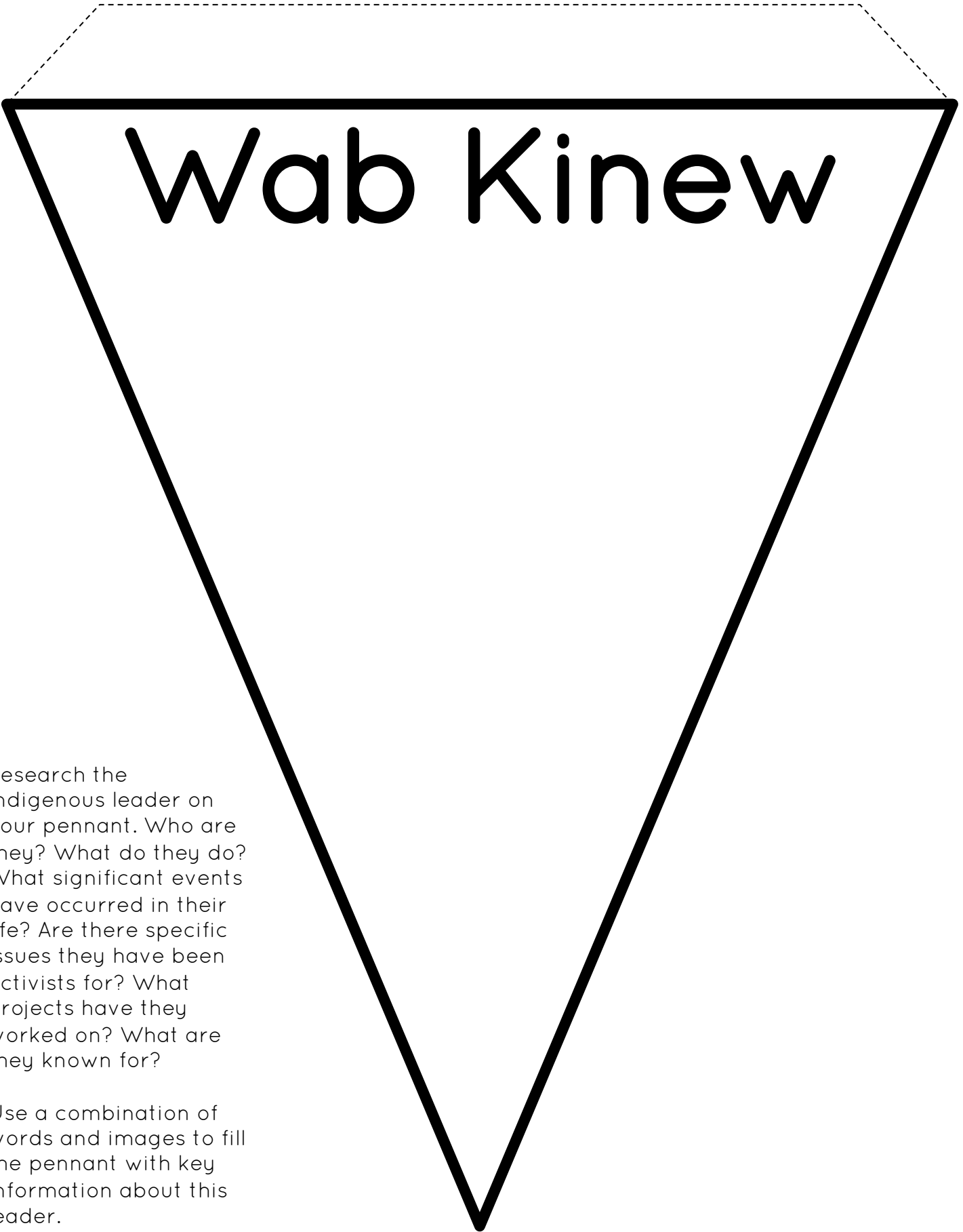
Instructions

Introduce the activity to students. Explain that there are many Indigenous leaders in Canada that are often not well known. Hand out a pennant to each student and explain that each name is an individual who is a leader in their field, whether that be art, music, politics, or activism. Students can complete the assignment either in class if there is adequate access to computers, or at home. At the end of the activity you will have a finished pennant to display and use as an anchor for class discussions.

Construction

The pennant is designed to be quick and easy to put together. Once students have completed a pennant, simply cut it out, fold back the dotted tab, and glue over a length of string or ribbon.

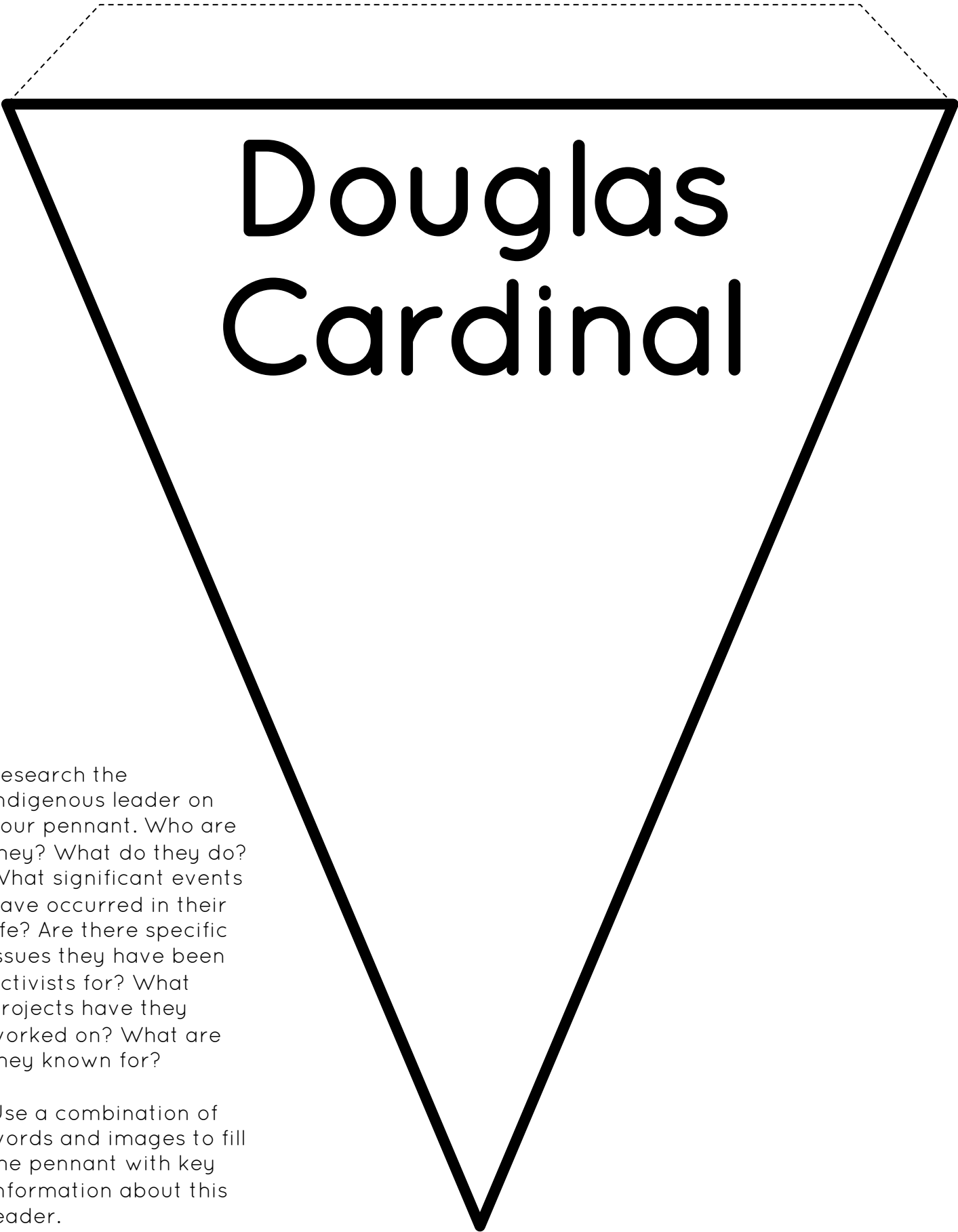
